Dear Members, Friends and Families:

My name is Joseph McAllister, and I'm a native Staten Islander and the Founder and President of the South Beach Civic Association. I am married to the former RoseAnn Iannelli and have one son Joseph, and three grandchildren, Joseph Jr., Nicky and Marissa, great grand baby Jr. and a dog named Snowygirl.

March of 2000, I was concerned with our quality of life in South Beach. Overdevelopment, roadways and crime was deteriorating the neighborhood. No one was coming forward to resolve the demoralizing issues constantly plaguing the area so I started to do it myself. First on my agenda was to do something about the overdevelopment. I went to the Department of City Planning and was told to map out an area and go lot to lot and record what I find on the map given to me from City Planning. This would be the first step in down zoning in order to stop the greedy builders from destroying our neighborhood. My grandson Joseph, wife Rosenn, and I worked for months scouting out the area and filling out the application for down zoning. When it was ready to be submitted we faced a road block: the cost was \$5,000.00 to file. We could not afford this. We were told if an organization could sponsor it, it would be free to submit. This was a problem because there was no civic or an organization available at the time to do this.

We worked with Lou Caravone, Chairman of Community Board 2. I was writing names of an organization to start and Lou suggested make it simple; name the group the South Beach Civic Association. The South Beach Civic Association was formed and the rest is history. Lou Caravone will always be remembered for all his diligent efforts in helping create the Civic.

The South Beach Civic Association is a group of neighboring, non-partisan citizens acting together to solve community problems. We strive to spark discussion and inspire civic achievement in order that everyone may enjoy their homes, families, neighborhood and quality of life. Every member of the civic and the community play a role in the process of critical thinking by bringing new ideas and diverse perspectives to the table. Through the work of the civic, members take an active role in bringing about improved safety to our roads, helping keep overdevelopment in check and increasing environmental awareness through recycling and efficient use of energy.

COMMUNITY

Since 1995, South Beach has been the site of a significant recreational waterfront development program. \$20 million has been allotted for improvements. The 1.7 mile South Beach boardwalk and 638-acre park offer visitors a restaurant and catering hall, the Ocean Breeze Fishing Pier, playgrounds, bike and walking paths, baseball fields, picnic areas, handball courts and a skateboard park. A senior park offers bocce courts, shuffleboard and checkerboard tables. The Boardwalk is bordered by Fort Wadsworth, a national park and one of the oldest military installations in the U.S., and Miller Field, a 187-acre open space with athletic fields, a picnic area, children's playground, a community garden, and walking trails. The crown jewel of South Beach is the Fountain of the Dolphins sculpture by Steven Dickey, donated by the Staten Island Borough President's Office in 1998.

The community supports a 4-acre property near Quintard Street that is a permanently protected portion of the Staten Island Bluebelt – an award-winning, ecologically sound and cost-effective storm water management system that uses man-made ponds rather than sewers to trap and filter floodwater and route it to the ocean at about half the cost of traditional sewers. Known as the South Beach Wetlands, it is an area of undeveloped wilderness and marshes that provides an important wildlife habitat for migratory birds and a diversity of plant life.

In the early 20th Century many Italian-Americans settled in the neighborhood. In more recent years, Russian, Chinese and Polish families are discovering South Beach. In addition to the many Russian businesses throughout the neighborhood, Kearny Bank, founded by Polish immigrants, has recently opened on Sand Lane. But long-established businesses, such as the A. Azzara Funeral Home, Arrochar Pharmacy, Key Food Supermarket, Sand Lane Laundry, Sand Lane Liquors, Italianissimo Restaurant, Tom's Auto Repair, Chinar on the Island Mediterranean Restaurant and Dragon House Chinese Cuisine continue to flourish in this diverse community.

When I was in grammar school my friends and I always came to South Beach to visit family. Roe also lived in South Beach. I moved here in 1978 and we raised a son, Joseph, here. I care about quality of life here. Since 2000, a great many things have changed. The neighborhood was being destroyed by over-development and we didn't want to see South Beach get torn apart. Rezoning—and proper enforcement—was needed desperately to stop greedy builders from destroying our community. We formed the Civic in order to build a coalition of people who wanted to work to preserve quality of life in our neighborhoods and try to give something back to a community that has been our home for so many years. THE CIVIC AT WORK

Protecting Our Natural Resources



Irresponsible building practices and rapid development threaten portions of our community's open space, damage infrastructure and create quality of life issues for residents.

In 2005/2006, the Civic, in its drive to protect and preserve the area's wetlands, worked in partnership with The Trust for Public Land, the Dept. of Environmental Protection and the N.Y.S. Department of Environmental Conservation to create what is now known as the South Beach Bluebelt. Bordered by Quintard Street, it is a 4-acre addition to the Staten Island Bluebelt whose benefits include improved drainage and flood control and a natural habitat for wildlife.



Enhancing Quality of Life



SKATE PARK — With the cooperative efforts of SBCA, other area organizations, Councilman Jim Oddo and the S.I. Borough President's office, the Benjamin Soto Memorial Skate Park opened April 1, 2005 at Midland Beach Park. Named for a 19-year-old Marine lance corporal who died in 2001 while serving in Okinawa, Japan, it has 24 components, including a 38-by-34-foot bowl and a quarter-pipe, and was designed with the help of local teenage skateboarders.

GRAFFITI — In a coordinated effort with the 122nd precinct and a team of volunteers from Dennis McKeon's Where to Turn, SBCA monitors, reports and arranges for the removal of graffiti in our community.

After Dennis' team removes it, Scott Lobaido, the artist behind "Flags Across Staten Island" paints a flag on the clean surface. The graffiti never turns up again.

Providing Safety on Our Roads



Joining forces with the Dept. of Transportation, SBCA works to make travel in and around our community safer for pedestrians and more accessible for motorists.

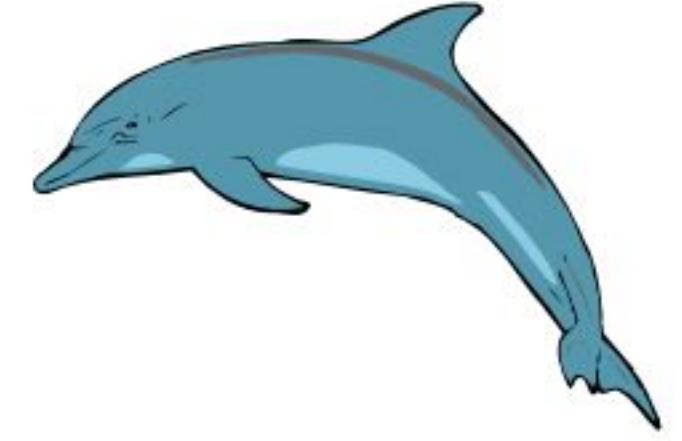
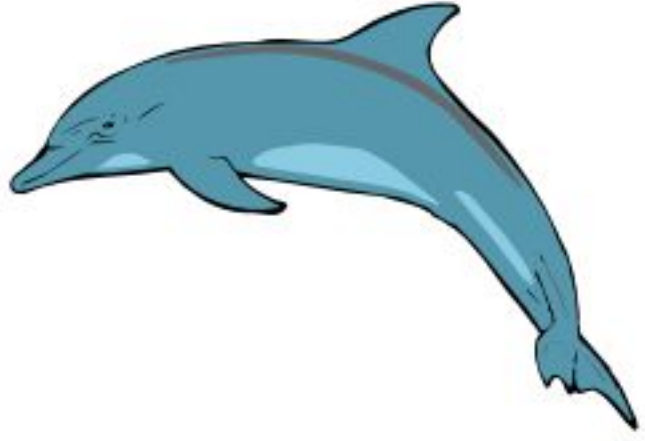
- Where two-way streets existed, one-way streets have been established, reducing truck traffic and excessive speed in our neighborhoods.
- NO PARKING signs have been installed at a sharp turn on Hastings St. and at the corners of the new one-way streets. Many of our streets have also been repaved.
- New street lights and traffic lights have been installed, including a left-turn signal at Fr. Capodanno Blvd. and Sand Lane.
- Parking for beach visitors and commuters has been expanded with the creation of the new Park and Ride Lot in South Beach and the newest parking lot at the northeast end of Fr. Capodanno Blvd.

What made you want to form the Civic?

Growing up I was told by my dad, Joseph Ianelli Sr., to always fight for what you believe in. I became a civic leader when seeing all the overdevelopment destroying Staten Island. Our wetlands needed to be protected for our wildlife which need to survive. We as human beings can't watch so much destruction without taking action on our quality of life issues. Helping people and animals to live in a peaceful world and work together is what I always hoped to achieve.

Between 2008 and 2010, city-wide budget cuts threatened to shutter our local firehouse, Engine 161. The South Beach Civic Association, working with Councilman Jim Oddo, brought together Island-wide civic organizations, retired firefighters, and many other state, city and local leaders to host a Town Hall Meeting and several city-wide rallies to inform the community and urge our elected officials to save our firehouse and protect the safety and well-being of residents in our community. In April 2010, the City Council and the Mayor's office announced all city firehouses would remain open.

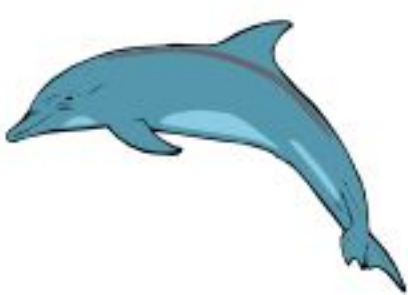

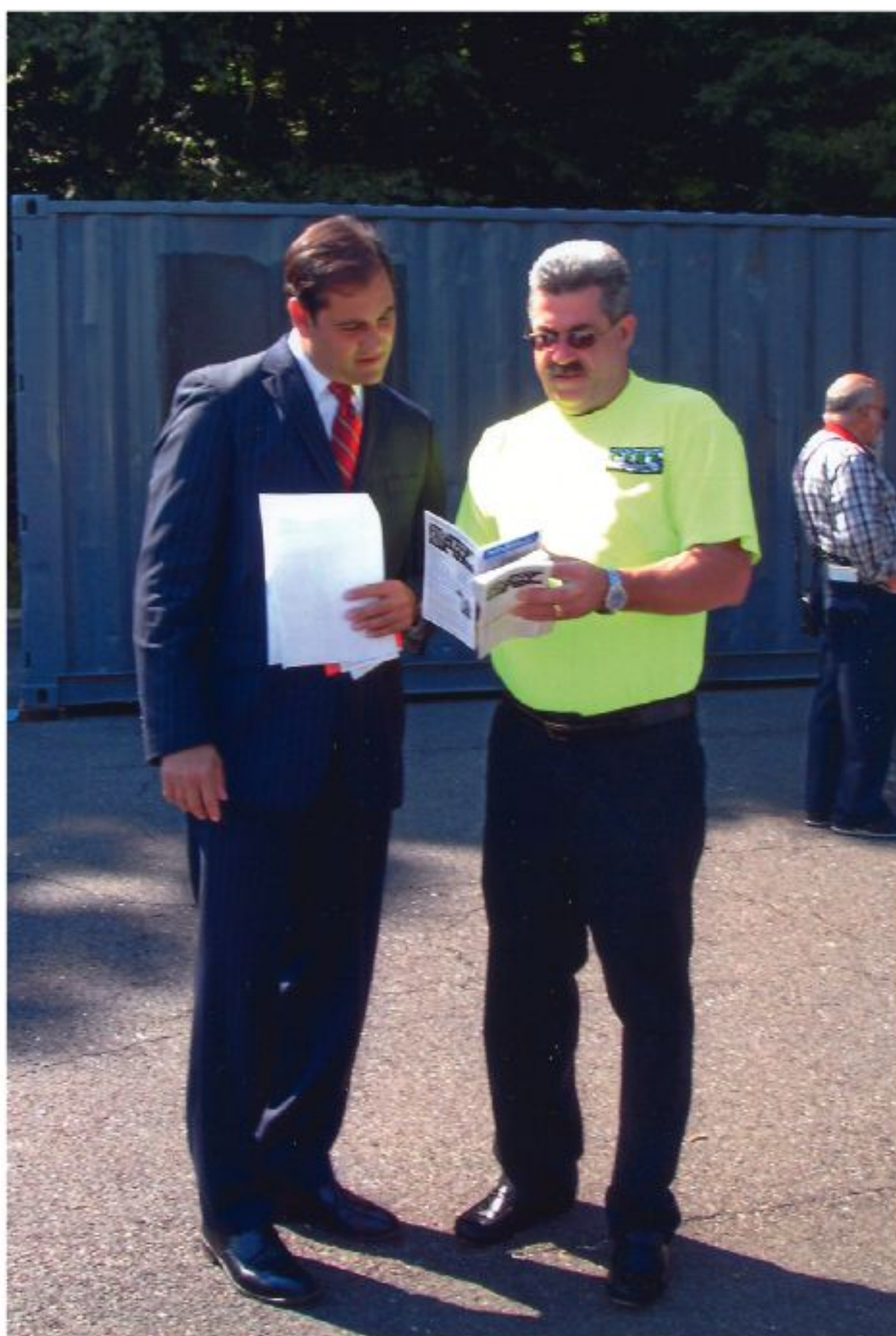


Community Emergency Response Training

C.E.R.T. - 1st Team to be trained on Staten Island

South Beach Civic Association was the first Staten Island community to be selected by the New York City Office of Emergency Management to train citizens to prepare for and respond to emergencies in their communities. It is one of four programs in the Department of Homeland Security's Citizen Corps initiative. Community-based volunteers undergo an intensive, 25-hour training program in basic disaster response skills, such as fire safety, light search and rescue, and medical operations. Activities also include educating neighbors and community business owners of the hazards they may face and appropriate steps to take in order to be prepared in the event of an emergency.

The third CERT training class graduated November 19, 2007. South Beach Civic Association thanks all who participated in the program on behalf of their community.

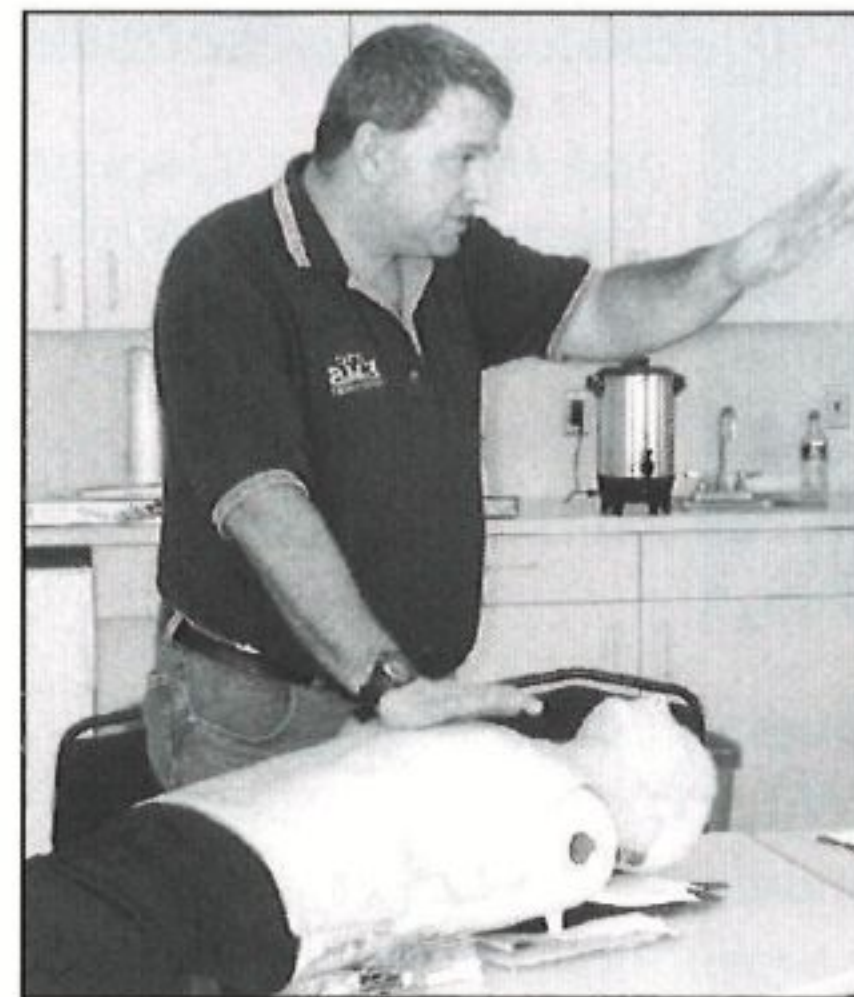
